



**Safety Instructions – Important! – Please read before using the cutter.**

**1. Work Area**

- a) The work area should be tidy and well lit.
- b) The work area should be well ventilated.
- c) Keep children, pets and bystanders away whilst using the tool.

**2. Personal Safety**

- a) Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when operating the tool. Do not use it if you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication.
- b) Use safety equipment – keep all body parts covered. Wear full face protection, gloves, ear defenders and dust mask.
- c) Dress appropriately – do not wear loose clothing or jewellery. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts.
- d) Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times.

**3. Care and Use**

- a) Keep idle tools out of the reach of children and do not allow person unfamiliar with the tool or these instructions to operate it.
- b) Only use the cutter on a grinder which is well maintained and in good condition.
- c) Always disconnect the power cord before fitting, removing or adjusting the cutter – follow specific instructions for this (part 4)
- d) Only use with grinders with a trigger which when released stops the power.
- e) Always use the cutter on a grinder with a side handle on the left side. Always use the grinder with the guard on. Always use the grinder with both hands. Maintain a firm grip and position your body and arm to resist kickback forces. Do not position your body in the area where the grinder will move if kickback occurs.
- f) Make sure the work piece is securely fixed and held in position by clamping or fixing by screws or other means. Do not under any circumstances steady or hold the work piece by hand.
- g) The cutter will cut with light to moderate pressure against the work piece. Do not use excessive pressure. Introduce the cutter to the work piece slowly.

h) Take time and learn how the grinder and cutter react to your inputs. Do not jerk or do sudden movements.

i) Only use the cutter on wood. Do not attempt to use it on metal or other materials. Make sure the wood is clean of nails and other obstructions before use.

#### **4. Instructions for fitting the cutter to an angle grinder.**

a) Ensure the grinder is unplugged.

b) The cutter should be screwed straight onto the grinder spindle (clockwise). All the threads within the cutter should be used. Dependant on grinder make and model the lower spacer on the spindle may need to be removed to allow the cutter to be fully fitted.

c) Tighten the cutter with a grinder key.

d) Manually rotate the cutter, making sure it does not contact the grinder guard at any stage. If the cutter makes contact with the guard it is incompatible with the grinder and should be removed and not used. Do not under any circumstances remove the grinder guard.

e) The cutter can now be used after following all the safety procedures.
